Excursion / Hike : Kromrivier Hike

The Kromrivier Hike is a popular trail in the Du Toitskloof with many a swimming holes and spectacular Fynbos and riverine forest. This trail crosses the Krom and Molenaars rivers, and after crossing Krom River, the vegetation becomes dense at the top end of the kloof. The path along the Krom River then leads on to a waterfall about 2.5km on. The last section of this path is surrounded by indigenous riverine forest. After the first waterfall, hikers will come to the second, truly spectacular, waterfall and large plunge pool (remember to bring your costume). Climbing between the first and second waterfalls can be tricky.

Transport Requirements:

Gantouw Tours and Excursions is able to provide transport for 4 guests in its vehicle, but it is recommended that guests provide their own transport. We will meet at the fenced parking site near the weigh-bridge on the Worcester side of the Du Toitskloof Tunnel. Please ask if you do not know the way.

Meals:

This is a full day excursion and guests are required to provide their own lunch and snacks. Gantouw Tours and Excursions, as part of the experience, will provide a lovely treat in the form of coffee/tea and a sweet delectable.

Cost:

R280 (ZAR) / adult and R65/child under 16 years age. A 50% deposit is required to secure your booking. This is used to make the booking and secure any permits if and where needed. The balance is due no later than commencement of walk.
